


## SOPs FOR FIXING URGENT PETITIONS

A meeting was held with Hon'ble Acting Chief Judge in Chair to discuss progress in Auto generated Cause list and other allied issues. It was decided that in future while fixing urgent petitions the following SOPs shall serve as guidelines for determining whether petition is urgent.

1. A Petition for suspension of any order or judgment.
2. A Petition for stay of execution/implementation or any executive order.
3. A petition for suspension of sentence.
4. A Bail petition.
5. An Election Petition or Review of decision on Election matters.
6. A Petition in pension matters.
7. A Petition in which a child or a woman is at immediate risk.
8. A Petition in which public at large is at immediate risk.
9. Consent Petition.
10. Withdrawal Petition.
11. A Petition for vacation of any order of any court/authority in which collection of public revenue is stayed .
12. A Petition in which Hon'ble Chief Judge considers taking circumstances to be of urgent nature.

Mere a case being old is not a ground for early fixation as purpose of Auto Generated cause list is to give priority to first come first.
